4.1. Participant Responsibilities

- Participants are responsible for all their own environment preparations, connectivity, and reference data download
- Participants are responsible to ensure that they have the necessary technical support on the day
- All users to log on and participate in the test
- Ensure that all fields are displayed correctly and as expected
- Ensure that all fields are enterable as expected
- Check that invalid field entries are not allowed
- Check that you have access to all functionality that you expect
- Clearing Members are responsible for identifying business as usual scenarios and check that all necessary functionality is available as expected
- Ensure that environments are properly prepared for start-up on Monday morning after the Nutron Upgrade Activities to avoid any issues with production.
- All system upgrade related issues must be logged with JSE Client Service Centre (011-520 7777)

- Data will be converted from production for the Nutron Upgrade Activities and should therefore be correct data
