SENS REPLACEMENT - AVAILABILITY OF CTS ENVIRONMENT FOR TESTING FROM 13 JULY 2026

Clients have been advised of a project to replace and modernise its **Stock Exchange News Service (SENS)** solution. The objective is to address evolving business and technology needs, as well as client requirements and known pain points with the existing SENS application.

The project is currently underway, with a **planned go-live date of 17 August 2026**. Market facing dress rehearsals are scheduled for 11 and 25 July 2026, where test announcements will be disseminated from the new SENS system. **Live Data subscribers** are encouraged to participate in limited regression testing during scheduled dress rehearsals.

For further regression testing, this communicate is to notify all live data feed subscribers, that **connect directly via the JSE data centre or via the JSE International Access point in London**, that the Client Test Environment (CTS) has been prepared and is available for regression testing from 13 July to 31 July 2026.

Note that it is mandatory for Trading Software Providers to conduct regression testing.
