IMPACT TO JSE IDP SERVER ACCESS DUE TO SECURITY CERTIFICATE RENEWAL – EFFECTIVE 3 JUNE 2017

Clients are advised that the JSE will be renewing the JSE security certificates, in line with IT Security best practice. These specific security certificates are set to expire on the 4th of June 2017 and will have an impact to IDP users making use of web services (HTTPS) to collect their files.

The new security certificate will be implemented on Saturday, 3 June 2017 at 08:00 AM post the delivery of the All Africa, International Indices and BDA dissemination files.

Post the implementation clients connecting via the Web services will be required to accept the new certificate when accessing the IDP service. Clients Connecting via FTPS will not be impacted as these certificates are only due for expiry in 2018.

Clients are urged to test connectivity to the IDP service during the course of Saturday, 3 June 2017.
