JSE Services Documentation – Draft Colocation Services Order Form (CSOF)

Clients are advised that the **draft** version of the **Colocation Services Order Form (CSOF)** is now available for perusal. Please note that the JSE is **not accepting** any order form submissions **at this stage** and will advise clients once order form submissions may commence.

The Colocation order form, once completed is submitted to the JSE for capturing and assignment of Hosting Unit (HU) details. The JSE then generate the Colocation Services Order Form (CSOF) which contains all the Hosting Unit information including full details of the Hosting Unit, Hosting Unit ID, assigned IP addresses etc.

The CSOF is then confirmed by the Customer and signed off by the JSE. The signed off CSOF can then be used to make a booking for the rack and stack of equipment in the Colocation facility.

Using the IP address information provided on the confirmed CSOF, clients can then commence their enablement requests for the services they wish to subscribe to from Colocation.
