MODULUS 10 CHECK DIGIT VALIDATION

A number of members have raised the concern that they are running out of account numbers in the client account range. As a way of addressing this concern, the JSE is investigating the removal of the MOD10 Check Digit on Client Accounts in BDA.

The MODULUS 10 Check Digit Validation (also known as the LUHN Formula) is a simple checksum formula used to validate numbers. It was designed to protect against accidental errors, not malicious attacks^{*}. The JSE is aware that some members include this validation in internal systems and we would like members to advise us if the removal of this validation will impact their internal systems.

As this is an urgent matter, we would appreciate if members and/or your service provider can advise the JSE if the removal of the MODULUS 10 Check Digit calculation from BDA will have any impact on your internal systems. If there is an impact, we would also appreciate if you could provide the JSE a high level assessment of the impact. This information is required as the JSE needs to make a decision on the way forward.
