Information Delivery Portal (IDP) - Users connecting via HTTPS connection protocol

Users are advised that the JSE has identified an issue with clients connecting to IDP via the **HTTPS connection protocol**. Clients are advised to make use of the alternative connection protocol available i.e. FTP and FTPS depending on whether you connect via the internet, via direct leased lines to the JSE or via third party telecommunications provided to the JSE.
