JSE Equity Market – Test Schedule for Production Testing 29 March 2014

Further to Service Hotline 21413 issued 30 December 2013, clients are reminded of the JSE production changes and testing scheduled for Saturday, 29 March 2014.

This test is a **key activity** to prove the go live **configuration changes** to the **Equity Market production system** as well as the **new Gateways** being introduced as part of the **JSE Colocation Service** go live on 12 May 2014.

Client testing will take place between 08h30 and 11h00 SAST. During the test the JSE will simulate a normal business day including trading session transitions. Clients will be able to confirm their connectivity to all the Gateways they subscribe to, the flow of multicast data as well as existing order and trade confirmation functionality.

The weekend's test is **to prepare for the full market facing test** and proposed schedule as will be used **for Saturday**, **5 April 2014**. Participation in the 29 March 2014 weekend test is **Optional**; however the JSE strongly recommends that clients take the opportunity to participate in preparation for the **mandatory test next weekend**.
