### INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION BENCHMARK (ICB) CHANGES – AVAILABILITY OF CSV FORMAT EQUIVALENT OF INTRADAY SNAPSHOT DATA PRODUCT

According to our records, your company subscribes to the fixed width data record format Indices Intraday Snapshot data product that the JSE derives rather than obtaining directly from FTSE Russell.

This data product is made available at around 3pm each day via our IDP FTP server as with the following file name: **DDAP.SPRD.<Client Alpha Code>.III15.zip**

We announced that ICB changes will not be made to any current Indices fixed width format data records. All ICB relevant fields will be replaced with fillers and instead a new CSV format equivalent file that includes the relevant ICB fields and changes will be made available. **This includes the above mentioned Indices Intraday Snapshot value-add data product.**

In line with this, please find details of the CSV format version of the Indices Intraday Snapshot data file. If you have an interest in, and use ICB data, then you will have to obtain that data from the new CSV equivalent file.
