The Issuer may at its election, but subject to the prior written approval of the Registrar of Banks, having given not less than 20 nor more than 40 days' notice to the Transfer Agent, the Calculation Agent, the Paying Agent, and the Noteholders (in the manner set out in Condition 19) (which notice shall be irrevocable) redeem all, but not only some, of the Notes in this Tranche on the date redemption stipulated in such "Capital notice (the Disqualification Event Redemption Date") if a Capital Disqualification Event occurred and is continuing, provided that the Issuer shall only be entitled to exercise this option prior to the First Optional Redemption Date.

The Notes shall be redeemed at a redemption price per Note calculated on the standard pricing methodology set out in the "BESA Floating rate Note (FRN) Formula Specifications" dated 13 October 2006 published by the JSE. The trading spread to be used as input for the calculation will be the lower of

(i) the margin at issue (being 275 basis points) and (ii) the related BP spread, as published by the JSE on their daily marked-tomarket report on the Business Day prior to the date on which the Capital Disqualification Event occurred. The linear swap curve published by the JSE on the Business Day prior to the Capital Disqualification Event Redemption Date will be used for this calculation. Should any of the aforegoing information not be published by the JSE on that day, then the Calculation Agent shall do the calculation based on the last publication of such information by the JSE. From the date of publication of notice of redemption pursuant to this Item 67, the Issuer shall make available, at 100 Grayston Drive, Sandton, for inspection by any holder of Notes to be so redeemed, a certificate signed by directors of the Issuer stating that the Issuer is entitled to effect such redemption and setting forth a statement of facts showing that the conditions precedent to the right of the Issuer so to redeem have occurred.
