Amendments to the JSE Listings Requirements

The Financial Markets Act No. 19 of 2012 (the “**FMA**”) came into force on 3 June 2013. The FMA repeals the Securities Services Act No. 36 of 2004 (the “**SSA**”).

As a consequence and in line with the transitional arrangements of the FMA, the JSE must amend the JSE Listings Requirements (the “**Requirements**”) to align same with the provisions of the FMA. The affected sections to the Requirements are:

- Definitions
- Introduction
- Section 1 - Authority of the JSE
- Section 3 - Continuing Obligations
- Section 5 - Methods and Procedures of Bringing Securities to Listing
- Section 22 - Accreditation of Auditor, Reporting Accountants and IFRS Advisers.
- Schedules - Schedule 16

All amendments to these sections have been marked-up for review.
